The Music Makers Assembly will have your students clapping, moving and tapping to the beat as we sing songs and do musical activities that focus on rhythm, movement, body percussion, mouth vocables, singing, tonality, tempo and dynamics. We will sing, dance, laugh, play with rhythm instruments, move, and create beautiful music.

Music making is a universal language that every child is entitled to enjoy. It is a fantastic coordination of fingers, hands, arms, lips, cheek and facial muscles. It requires extraordinary control of the diaphragm, back, stomach, and chest muscles, which respond instantly to the sound the ear hears and the mind interoperates. It allows a human being to take all these techniques and use them to create emotion.

Teachers as well as students will be encouraged to participate in singing and movement. We know that some children are excellent observers and prefer to watch and listen before joining in, so teachers will be encouraged to allow their students the freedom to participate at their own comfort level. Participation is the goal, but it is also beneficial for a child to simply enjoy observing the experience. Each child will have an opportunity to play rhythm instruments, and everyone will sing, dance, move, laugh and have fun.
